**Aviel Sela, a missionary in Israel,
met Joshua, an Iranian Jewish car
park attendant.**

I noticed the sadness in his eyes so I talked with him about how we can know peace. Joshua shared his life story with me. He was born into an

Iranian Jewish family in 1940. In 1974, he moved to Israel. His wife gave birth to a boy and a girl there, and, as his family grew, so did his business. Things seemed secure for the family. Sadly, this didn't last long. Their 15-year-old daughter suddenly became ill. Despite the best doctors they could afford, tragically, she died at age 23. Joshua sought peace for himself and his wife but could never find it. This was why he was so interested when I talked to him about finding peace with God. I shared with him that the only way to have real peace was through the Messiah. I explained that God gives true peace to those who trust in

Jesus for salvation. Over 4 months, I answered his questions.

I could see that God was drawing him to faith. Eventually, I asked him who he thought the Messiah was. He told me that as he had read Isaiah 53, it became clear to him that Jesus was the Messiah and God! It was an overwhelming moment as we prayed together and Joshua repented of his sins, receiving Jesus as his Lord and Messiah. Finally at the age of 78 he was born again, and found the peace that he had been looking for all his life—peace with God.
