Hello and welcome to this weeks Bible Club story. Last week you read about the first miracle of Jesus, when he turned water into wine at a wedding. His disciples realised that Jesus was very special. Jesus did many more miracles while he was on earth.

Today's miracle can be found in the Bible in Luke chapter 8 verses 43-48, which says:

⁴³ And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, but no one could heal her. ⁴⁴ She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped.

⁴⁵ "Who touched me?" Jesus asked.

When they all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you."

⁴⁶ But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me."

⁴⁷ Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed. ⁴⁸ Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace."

We start with a woman who was very sad. She had been very ill for 12 years and no-one was able to make her better. She had spent all her money going to see doctors she just got worse, because she kept bleeding.


This woman had heard about Jesus, and she felt sure that if only she could see Jesus, he would be able to make her well again.

When she got to where Jesus was, a very large crowd of people had gathered all around him. She thought to herself, "If only I could touch his clock, I would be made well."
